Description of the Safety and Steering Committee in the Bylaws

This committee promotes and educates Members on the importance of safety for all Club activities, maintains, and amends the Club's Safety and Steering Policies and Procedures. The committee shall:

1. Be responsible for inspection and maintenance of Club safety equipment and make recommendations to the Board for its improvement and or replacement.;
2. Educate prospective and current Steerspersons on all aspects of safety in and out of the canoe and conduct regular classes to assure Steerspersons are qualified to retain status as a Steersperson in non-competitive outrigger activities;
3. Foster a collaborative environment through education, awareness, and transparency, and
4. Be responsible for conducting comprehensive, safety-focused workshops and mentoring programs for all prospective Steerspersons to assure Steerspersons abide by the Safety and Steering Policies and Procedures.
