James F. Rogers Academic Achievement Scholarship: \$2000: one year

The James F. Rogers Academic Achievement Scholarship is open to any West Hawaii graduating senior with a 3.0 GPA or higher, who has demonstrated academic achievement and community participation, and has paddled at the club or high school level in the past three years.

Mike Haines Merit Achievement Scholarship: \$2000: one year

The Mike Haines Merit Achievement Scholarship is open to any West Hawaii graduating senior who has paddled at the high school or club level in the past three years. In addition to strong academics, the candidate demonstrated active volunteerism and leadership in the school, community, church and/or employment environments.

The deadline for receipt of scholarship packets is May 01, 2023. Applicants will be considered for either scholarship as appropriate. Your scholarship packet needs to include the following items:

- 2) Most recent high school transcript, ACT and/or SAT
- 3) Three letters of reference from teachers, paddling coach, or community supporter
- 4) Personal statement of one page describing your background and academic preparation, paddling experience at the club or school level of competition in the last 3 years, community service or merit-based experience, and employment. If space allows, describe your interests, goals and aspirations in seeking education at the next level.

Submit your packet to Scholarship Committee Chair, Keauhou Canoe Club, P.O. Box 390755, Keauhou, Hawaii 96739. The Scholarship Committee will review all applicant materials and select the candidate who best meets the intent of each scholarship award.
